



Enhanced Guidelines for Community Use of Schools 2021-2022

Access:

All visitors are required to wear a mask while on school premises.

RCDSB schools will be available for rental between 6:30pm-9:30pm on regular school days, starting October 1st, for youth programs only.

Once permits are approved, alterations may not be made to ensure a consistent cleaning schedule.

There will be no daytime or weekend permits allowed at this time.

Only gymnasiums and auditoriums will be available for rentals.

A rental space will only be available to one group per night.

Program start times will be staggered for schools with more than one rental group, to reduce contact between users.

Changerooms will not be available for user groups. A designated washroom will be assigned.

Screening:

All participants must be listed on a roster with an email address that is attached to the permit. Permits will not be issued until the group roster has been received.

Group members will be required to complete the attached [attestation form](#) and provide copies to the permit supervisor.

Organizations must appoint a supervisor that is responsible for ensuring that all participants have completed the provincial screening [tool](#) and have received a green check mark prior to entering the school and that an accurate contact list is completed for each rental.

The supervisor must have a process for contact tracing (see Appendix A) and retaining all sign in lists for a period of 30 days, and be able to provide the list to Public Health in the event of an outbreak.



The supervisor or an appropriate delegate must be on site for all rental dates.

The supervisor is responsible for ensuring that all attendees comply with all [public health requirements](#).

Non-participants (spectators) will not be permitted to enter the facility.

Communication:

In the event that a community use member tests covid positive, the Health Unit will contact the individual, club/league/user group and school, and will obtain attendance lists for contact tracing from the user group.

It is highly encouraged that groups members notify the Community Use Coordinator in the event of a positive Covid result.
