Season INFO

The Season runs from September until the end of April, ending with Provincial Championships. Teams will compete in a minimum of 5 OVA sanctioned tournaments during the year, including Provincials. Teams may choose to attend Nationals, location dependant.

Tournament locations:

In years past, the furthest teams have had to travel for tournaments is Oshawa and Markham, with places in between and are ONE DAY. Provincial Championships will be held in Toronto this year, and is a 3 day event. The club will be exploring the option to host tournaments locally.

Practice Times:

Vikings will practice two times per week, 2 hours each night with the possibility of some additional team building, skill development, conditioning etc... throughout the year. Specific practice time and location for each age group will be communicated before the end of tryouts.

Playing Time:

This is a competitive club, wins are not everything but it is the goal every time we step on the court. Players will receive FAIR playing time, NOT EQUAL playing time.

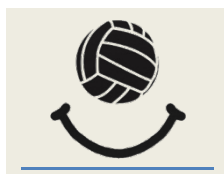
Last season the Vikings Volleyball club had 9 teams competing provincially. In the girls program we had 1 team at 13u, 2 at 14u, 2 at 15u, 2 at 16u, 1 at 17u and 1 at 18u. Our teams had one of their most successful seasons yet. The 18u girls won two bronze medals, the 17u won two bronze medals, the 16u won two bronze medals, the 14u won silver and gold medals, and the 13u won a bronze medal. Our season was cut short prior to the Provincial Championships due to the pandemic. From start to finish, all Vikings players in all age divisions showed tremendous personal and team growth. We look forward to seeing all the returning Vikings, and meeting some new ones, and watching you all grow.



A high level of performance is expected from each athlete, both in practice and in games.

PLAYER FEES: \$950.00 per player

The basic fees includes costs of uniforms (warm up, 2 jerseys, shorts) all OVA tournament entry fees, equipment, honorariums, and gyms. Player registration with Volleyball Canada and OVA (necessary for insurance) not included in registration.



BEHAVIOR: All Players and parents are expected to behave in a manner that brings credit to themselves and the club. Players must control their emotions at practice and tournaments. Disruptive behavior or unsportsmanlike conduct will NOT be tolerated.
